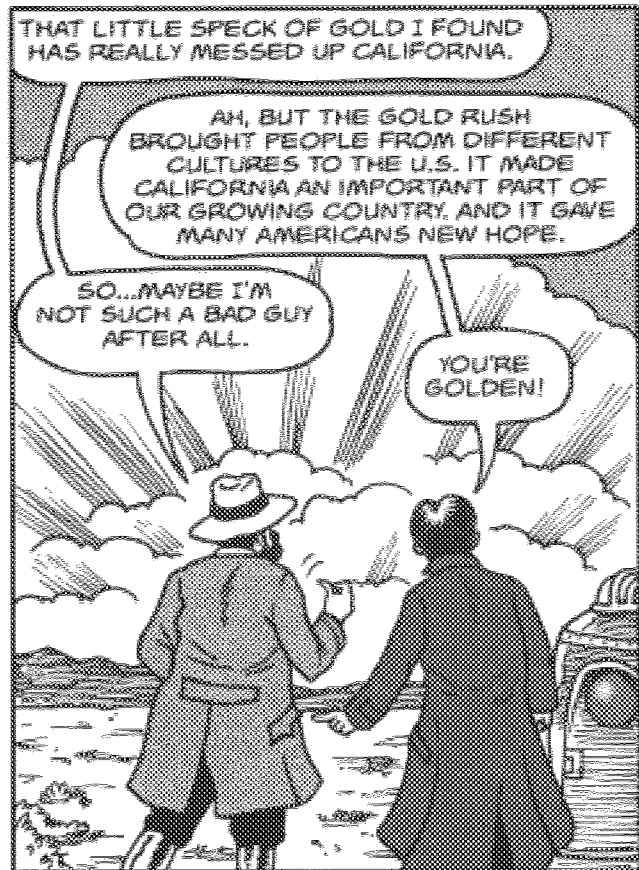
IN OTHER PARTS OF THE COUNTRY, THE DISCOVERY OF GOLD WAS CONSIDERED NOTHING BUT A RUMOR-- UNTIL DECEMBER 5, 1849, WHEN PRESIDENT JAMES K. POLK OFFICIALLY ANNOUNCED IT.

MEMBERS OF CONGRESS, I STAND BEFORE YOU TODAY TO CONFIRM THAT THERE IS INDEED GOLD IN CALIFORNIA-- AND IT'S PLENTIFUL!

IN 1849, AFTER POLK'S SPEECH, THOUSANDS OF PEOPLE-- CALLED "FORTY NINERS"-- FLOCKED TO CALIFORNIA. IT TOOK SIX MONTHS TO CROSS THE COUNTRY IN A WAGON. PEOPLE CAME BY SEA FROM OTHER PLACES, TOO: SOUTH AMERICA, ASIA, AUSTRALIA & EUROPE. IT WAS TRULY A GOLD RUSH.
